Furthermore, successful candidates are entitled for exemption from the Class-IV, Part-A Examination of the Directorate General of Shipping.

Eligibility Conditions for BTech ME - Lateral Entry to  $2^{nd}$  Year of BTech Marine Engineering Degree:

a. Marital Status: Unmarried

b. Age: Not more than 22 years

- c. Academic Standard: Passed 3 years Diploma course in Mechanical or Marine engineering from a college approved by AICTE or Department of Technical Education of the state Govt. with minimum 60% marks overall & completed Diploma course in 3 years.
- d. Language: Minimum score in English, either in Class X or Class XII 50%
- e. Eyesight: 6/12 in each eye or 6/9 in the better eye & 6/18 in the other eye. Corrective lenses permitted for the above.
- f. Medical: Physically fit and meet the standards laid out by DG Shipping & ESM / SIMS\*
- g. Candidates who have appeared for the last semester examinations and the results are yet to be declared are also eligible to appear
